1. Students who demonstrate sufficient English proficiency through the application may place out of this requirement and therefore, will not be responsible for the fee.
2. The installments due on January 3 and April 26, 2011 are \$26,900, based on the rate for the 2010-2011 academic year. Installments due on August 30, 2011 and January 4, 2012 will be based on the rate for the 2011-2012 academic year which will be determined in July, 2011.
3. Rates from the spring of 2010 are shown. Rates for the Class of 2012 will be determined in January, 2011.
4. Expenses in Ann Arbor are the responsibility of either the Sponsor Company or the student and will vary depending upon student preferences.
5. Based on rates effective through August 31, 2011; rates will likely increase in September, 2012.
6. Airfare expenses and reservations throughout the program are the responsibility of either the Sponsor Company or the student. Students from China, Japan, and Korea need to travel to two countries. Students from other countries need to travel to three countries.
7. Textbooks and course materials required for the core courses are prepared by the program office and the cost is invoiced directly to each student. Textbooks and course materials for the elective courses are purchased directly by the student.
